# 2010 Statewide Hurricane Exercise

- Exercise scenario involves a hurricane that impacts the state up through Tallahassee, requiring the SEOC to activate its Continuity of Operations Plan (COOP).
- Operations will occur in real time beginning Monday morning May 10 - 13, 2009.
- SEOC will relocate to Camp Blanding to resume operations.
- Multi-state operations are anticipated to last for at least one day (include Georgia and Alabama).

# 2010 Statewide Hurricane Exercise

- Preliminary planning efforts underway with Georgia and Alabama EM.
- Statewide planning efforts to commence in the near future. Information including the storm information, meeting dates and development plan will be disseminated in the coming months.

# Interoperability Summit

- Expected dates are January 25-29, 2010 at Camp Blanding.
- Cross-section of agencies within each region (Federal, state, military, FCC, etc).
- All will bring vehicles, communication equipment and personnel.
- Training and exercises are planned to test the abilities of each agency/region to communicate with each other.
- Hoping to have the largest IO Summit in the US with over 350 attendees possible.

# Mitigation Summit

- January or February, two days in Orlando.
- Will have vendors present.
- There will be no formal training but there will be presentations regarding changes during the past year to Federal hazard mitigation grant programs.
- Discussions on post-disaster loss avoidance and grants management.
- Open to all, not just EM. Includes private sectors as well.

# F-SERT

- Forward SERT concept.
- Drafted in the wake of large events like Katrina when one command team is not sufficient or when multiple events impact one state.
- In this case, the state would be divided into separate regions and a team would be deployed for 30 days.
- Forward SERT Guidelines in final draft.
