

# FEMA Grants Programs Update and Emphases

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# Region IV Current Emphases

- \* Continuing the transition - HQ managed grants to Regional managed grants
- \* Whole Community concepts in planning – inclusion of non-traditional partners, etc.
- \* Measureable grant activities & reporting – seen as needed for continued legislative/Congressional support
- \* Improving EHP support in RIV – now have added preparedness grant support
- \* Close-outs of old grants (non-disaster and disaster grants)



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# Grants Management Division

Grants transferred to Region IV in FY 11 included:

- \* EMPG
- \* EOCs
- \* MMRS
- \* Community Prep/Citizen Corps
- \* Driver's License Security Grants

Additional grant transfers being piloted in other FEMA Regions in FY 12 – expected results will mean additional transfers to all Regions in FY13



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# R IV Grants Management Division

## Grant Proposal Development

- \* Provides or brokers assistance to potential recipients in developing proposals – “helpful hints” on guidance, etc.
- \* Provides assistance in “navigation” of grant processes

## Grant Award and In-Progress Assistance

- \* Upon award, assists recipients in interpretation of guidance, provides periodic program/financial monitoring (not audits)

## Closeout and Final Reporting Assistance

- \* Technical/administrative help in management of closeouts

## FY 2011 (Enacted)

- > AFG: \$ 808,380,000
  - fire grants \$ 404,190,000
  - SAFER \$ 404,190,000
- EMPG: \$ 339,320,000
- Cit Corps: \$ 9,980,000
- SHSGP: \$ 578,840,000
- DLSGP: \$ 44,910,000
- MMRS: \$ 34,930,000

## FY2012 (Proposed)

- > AFG: \$ 670,000,000
  - fire grants \$ 250,000,000
  - SAFER \$ 420,000,000
- EMPG: \$ 350,000,000
- Cit Corps: \$ 13,000,000
- SHSGP: \$1,050,000,000
- DLSGP: \$ 0
- MMRS: \$ 0
