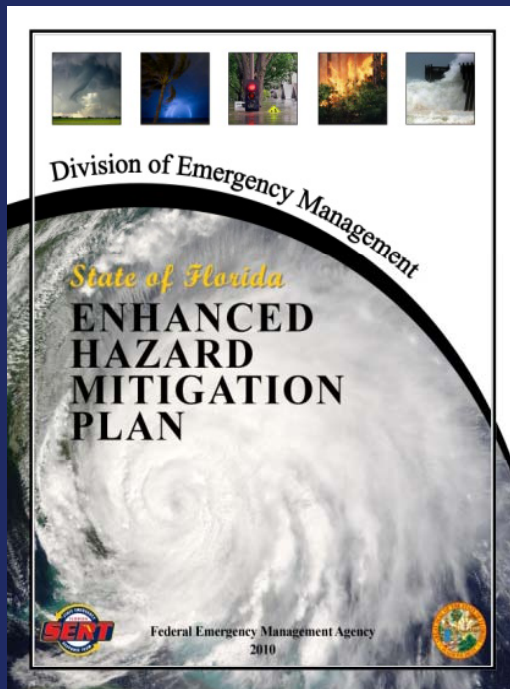

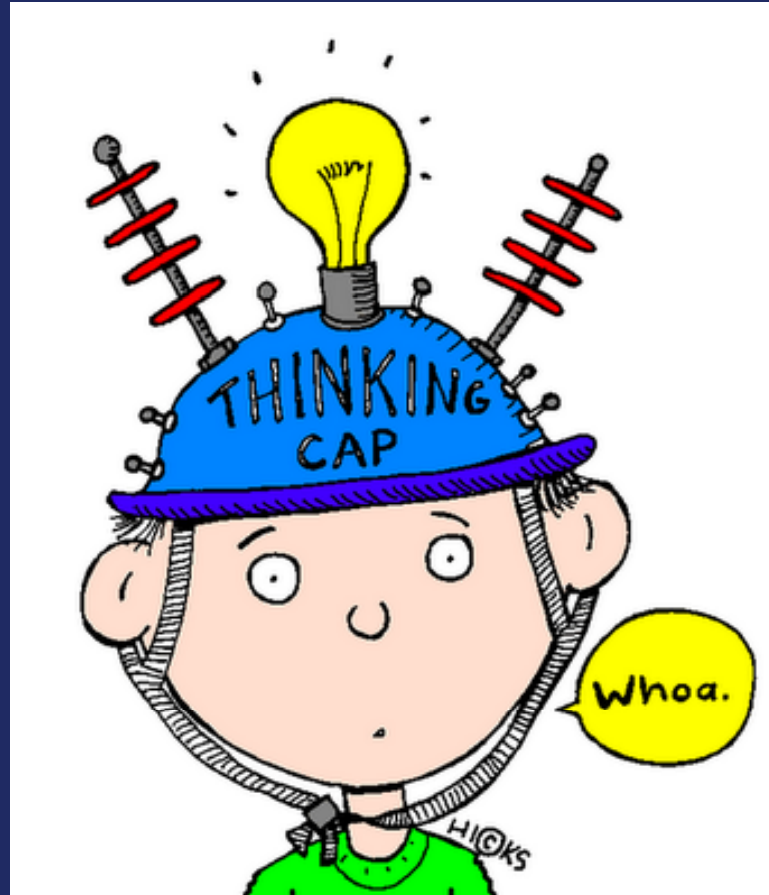

# Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG)

- FEMA funded
- Supports comprehensive emergency management at the state and local levels
- Encourages improvement in mitigation, preparedness, response, and recovery capabilities for all hazards



# EMPG Use

- Funds are generally used to:
  - implement state priorities and maintain or expand capacity
  - Planning, exercise, and training
  - Implement NIMS and NRF elements
- Fiscal Year 2007-2009 = \$36 M



# Examples of Funded Projects

- Hazardous Weather Awareness Week
- “Get-a-Plan” Campaign and Outreach
- Community & Disability Outreach Campaigns
- Mitigation training at the Florida Governor’s Hurricane Conference
- Mitigation training at FEPA
- Training exercises for regional CERTs
- Catastrophic Event Vulnerability & Gap Analysis
- Evacuation and large scale relocation planning
- Community Outreach – All Hazards Preparedness and Mitigation
- Upgrade to interoperable communications
- Update of state website



# Florida Hurricane Catastrophe Fund (FHCF)

- Reinsurance program
- Covers residential structures
- Can reduce long-term economic impacts of hurricanes by maintaining state's property insurance capacity
- Supports implementation of hurricane mitigation projects through annual funding of RCMP and other programs



# Emergency Management Preparedness and Assistance (EMPA) Competitive Grant Program

- Created from FHCF
- Supports preparedness, response, recovery, and mitigation related activities
- DCA administers funds gathered from annual surcharge on homeowners



# Fund Distribution

- 60% to implement State and local emergency management programs and training
  - 20% used by Division
  - 80% allocated to local emergency management
- 20% to provide State relief assistance for non-federally declared disasters
- 20% for competitive grants and loans to State or regional agencies, local governments, and private organizations



# Competitive Grants

## Emergency Management Competitive Grant Program

- Provides competitive grants to state, regional, local governments, and private non-profits organizations to implement projects that further state and local emergency management objectives
- Only 3 applications per applicant
  - County and state agencies excepted

## Municipal Grant Competitive Grant Program

- Provides competitive grants to municipalities that are legally constituted and have signed the Statewide Mutual Aid Agreement
- Must have authorized emergency management program
- Each program may apply for one competitive grant not to exceed \$50,000

- 2006/2007 & 2007/2008 Hurricane Mitigation & Preparedness Public Education Statewide Media Campaign
- The Avon Park Citizen Emergency Response Team Project
- The Florida Small Business Disaster Survival Kit Update & Spanish Translation
