CURRENT SITUATION:

The State Emergency Operations Center is currently at Level 2 Activation and continuing to respond to the effects of Tropical Depression Ernesto along the Florida Keys and Florida Peninsula.

WEATHER SUMMARY:

Monroe County: Scattered showers and thunderstorms, mainly after noon. Skies will be partly cloudy, with a high near 90. West wind around 8 mph. Chance of precipitation is 50%.

Miami-Dade County: Scattered showers and thunderstorms, mainly after noon. Skies will be partly cloudy, with a high near 90. Heat index values as high as 101. West wind around 9 mph. Chance of precipitation is 50%.

Collier County: Showers and thunderstorms likely, mainly after noon. Skies will be partly cloudy, with a high near 90. Heat index values as high as 101. West wind around 7 mph. Chance of precipitation is 60%.

Broward County: Showers and thunderstorms likely, mainly after noon. Skies will be partly cloudy, with a high near 90. Heat index values as high as 101. West wind around 7 mph. Chance of precipitation is 60%.
