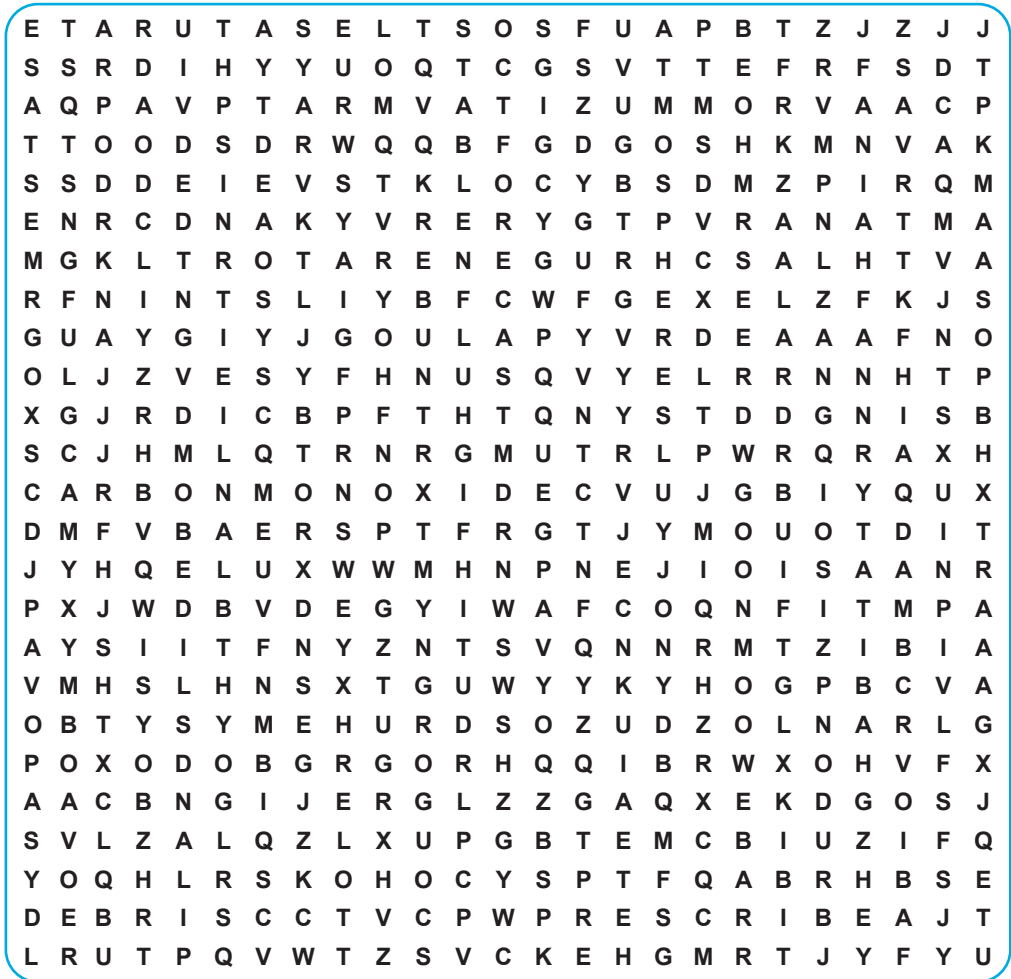


HAZARDOUS WEATHER AWARENESS WORD JUMBLE
