Elevate Florida is an innovative statewide initiative aimed at improving the resilience of around **2,000** homes by using more than **\$400 million** in federal funding.

### Program Update

The Elevate Florida program received more than 12,000 applications. Due to the high volume of applications and the fixed federal funding allocation, all available resources will be committed to serving the most at-risk properties.

The program will begin notifying property owners who will not move forward in the program by August.

Over the next few months, additional inspections will be scheduled, construction vendors will be selected and onboarded.

Property owners with an Elevation Certificate (EC) less than five years old should upload it to the Elevate Florida portal to avoid duplicate costs. Property owners should not obtain a new EC on their own, as this will be coordinated through the program.
