The Intern will be matched with projects based on their interests and the needs of the Office of Inspector General (OIG), contributing to meaningful work that supports accountability and good governance in emergency management.

We provide objective, fact-based assessments of FDEM programs and operations, including audits, investigations, inspections, and other oversight activities. - Conduct research, analyze evidence, and draw fact-based conclusions.
- Develop a written report of conclusions and any related recommendations.
- Gain exposure to government oversight as well as Florida's emergency management processes.
- Collaborate with experienced professionals in a supportive, mission-driven environment.
