



Division of Emergency Management Enterprise Solutions (DEMES) State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program (SLCGP) Application Requirements

Updated October 9, 2025



Once you have completed the application, you will need to upload it and any supporting documents to the DEMES Grants Portal. If you do not already have access, this guide will instruct you on registering and uploading your grant application.

To apply for SLCGP:

You must submit SLCGP applications and associated documents through DEMES.

This requires someone from your entity to register in DEMES to submit your application and associated documents. Please see instructions for registration and application submission in DEMES below:

- How to register as a user in DEMES.
- How to submit your entity's completed application and associated documentation in DEMES for review.

To access DEMES:

If you are already registered in DEMES:

- 1. Log in at www.FDEMPortal.com/grants using your existing username and password.
- 2. If you are having issues with your username and/or password, please contact DEMES.Support@em.myflorida.com or Myron.Rozier@em.myflorida.com.

If you are not yet registered in DEMES:

- Go to https://www.fdemportal.com/grants and select "Register."
 Follow the prompts and make sure to select your appropriate entity account.
- 2. On the register page, enter in your personal details in the fields provided. Required fields are marked with a red asterisk.
 - Fields include: First Name, Last Name, Entity (e.g., Polk County Sheriff's Office), Division, Role, Email, Username (auto populates when you click on it if your email is filled out), Create Password, and Confirm Password.
- 2. Click "Sign Up" to submit your request.
- 3. Type your entity's name in the Enter Account Name box and click "Enter."
- 4. Select the appropriate account and click "Request Access."
 - If you can't find your entity's account, select "Can't find your account?" to create a new
 account for your entity if one does not already exist. Next, the final registration page
 will appear.
 - Type in your business phone number (required field), extension, and mobile phone number.
 - Select "Grants Management."
 - Note this selection does not limit you to only working with preparedness.
 - In the text field under "Reason for Requesting Access," type "Apply for State and Local Cyber Security Grant Program (SLCGP)."
- 5. A pop-up confirming your request will appear. Click "Finish" to submit.


The FDEM DEMES team will review your request on weekdays and approve it in 48 hours. Then you will be able to submit your complete SLCGP application and supporting documents through a link valid for 24 hours.

To submit your completed application and supporting documents:


NOTE: You cannot edit your application once it is submitted in DEMES. Please do not start the submission process until your application is complete.

- 1. Once you are logged into the DEMES Grants Management portal through the above steps and have completed your entity's application and supporting documents, select Legislative Appropriation Program tab on the home page.
- 2. Select the State and Local Cyber Security Grant.
- 3. Click on the Create Legislative Appropriation Program (LAP) Application tab.
- 4. Next, choose the LAP grant name, SLCGP.
- 5. In the bottom-left corner, click on the Upload File tab. This will open your desktop so you can select and upload the required documents.
- 6. Once the upload is complete, click "Done," then select "Next" to see the confirmation.
