



## **Flood Mitigation Assistance (FMA) Program Fiscal Year 2024 Notice of Funding Opportunity**

The Florida Division of Emergency Management is pleased to announce the republishing of the Flood Mitigation Assistance (FMA) Program for Fiscal Year 2024. The funding opportunity was originally published on Jan. 6, 2025. Then on April 30, 2026, FEMA published an amendment to the funding opportunity that incorporates recent federal guidance and aligns with overarching national goals.

Due to this funding opportunity being revised and republished, eligible entities that submitted a subapplication under the previous FY 2024 FMA application period are invited to reapply for the same projects for funding consideration under this opportunity. All subapplicants must have an approved LMS plan to participate in this funding opportunity.

The FMA FY 2024 subapplicants will be contacted directly with an invitation to reapply and will be provided with information on the submission deadline and how to resubmit the subapplications via the FEMA GO application system. If access is needed for any new users, please follow the steps to create an account in FEMA GO. Each entity's Subrecipient Authorized Representative has permissions to add new users once they have created accounts in FEMA GO.

### **Funding Overview**

**A total of \$600 million in funding is available nationwide, supporting:**

- Capability- and capacity-building activities tied to infrastructure resilience: \$60 million
- Localized flood risk reduction projects subtotal: \$420 million
- Individual flood mitigation projects subtotal: \$120 million

**Funding is distributed across multiple categories, including:**

- National Competition
- State/Territory Allocations
- Tribal Set-Aside
