Governor Scott Declares a State of Emergency in Florida in Preparation for Tropical Depression Nine

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. – Today, Governor Rick Scott issued Executive Order 16-205 declaring a state of emergency in 42 counties within the state of Florida in preparation for Tropical Depression Nine. To view Executive Order 16-205, click <u>HERE</u>.

Governor Scott said, "Last night, hurricane and tropical storm watches were issued along Florida's Gulf Coast from Pasco County to Gulf County. We also learned that the National Hurricane Center expects Tropical Depression Nine to become a Tropical Storm sometime today.
